### All types of contracting services

The service line's procurement specialists secure contracts in four areas:

- **Construction contracting**, which includes new construction, renovation, repair or demolition work—as well as site preparation, excavation, seismic investigation, and associated material and equipment supply—for buildings, structures or other infrastructure-related facilities.
- **Consultant contracting**, which encompasses services delivered by professionals, including research and scientific studies, architectural and engineering design, planning and development, and data collection, auditing and processing.
- **Service contracting**, which is comprised of additional services provided to DND by external resources.
- **Goods contracting**, which consists of goods such as raw materials, products and equipment related to moveable property.





The Contract Services team can also manage a procurement project to suit any client's precise needs. For example,

- **quick-response tenders** enable DCC to award contracts for small, uncomplicated construction projects within 14 days,
- **tender boards** are ideal media for minor, time-sensitive construction work (DCC can usually award these contracts in 25 days or less),
- **design-build projects** are best suited to major capital works and facilitate quicker project delivery compared to design-bid-build models, and
- **source lists for professional services** provide DND with access to lists of pre-qualified professional services firms, thereby reducing contracting effort and duration.

For infrastructure-related projects, the team offers a variety of contracting options, including:

- standing offers,
- lump sum contracts,
- best value contracts,
- facility maintenance contracts,
- energy performance contracts, and
- construction management contracts.
